Participating educators become "Leading Edge Certified" upon successful completion of the program. Successful completion includes:

- Completion of the 60-70 hour (9 week) Leading Edge Certification (LEC) online course
- Completion of a professional portfolio containing signature assignments from the LEC course, based upon the Standards for Coaches (ISTE Standards - C).

Participants should have proficiency with web-based tools, experience with discussion boards, and knowledge of online tools and resources available in their subject area.
